JUMP! is a project that will create a European vision for vocational training in eco-construction by establishing support and resources for trainers. The aim is to develop quality and trust, initially within the consortium and, ultimately, within a large European network of eco-construction training organisations.

Since September 2017 JUMP! has involved 6 European countries represented by 8 organisations in 9 monthly coordination meetings, 2 international meetings and numerous working group meetings.

The goal of BiWeNa is the development of vocational training in ecological construction.



EBUKI: Earth Building UK & Ireland founded in 2007 is committed to promoting the development of earth construction



This Swedish initiative aims to develop values such as trust and to develop the creative abilities of individuals and organisations.



The French network of straw bale construction, founded in 2006, is the first European organization to develop professional training with straw.

During the 3 year duration of the project there will be 7 international meetings and many national meetings to create:

- **5 preliminary inventories** 1 Concepts & values, 2 Activities & competence of trainers, 3 existing competency frameworks, 4 Tools for measuring environmental impact, 5 Methods of support for change
- 1 charter
- 1 competence standard
- 1 training resource 3 or 4 modules and the corresponding teaching tools. This resource will then be tested twice at the end of the project.

The second meeting was held in France from April 16 to 19, 2018

At the first meeting in Sweden from 16 to 20 October 2017, three days of workshops, interspersed with coordination time were led by the Swedish partner Johannesdals Initiativ Tillitsverket to question the teaching of sustainable construction through the notions of awareness, creativity, trust, change and cooperation.

The second meeting aimed to:

- **continue the coordination work:** make an intermediate assessment, allow everyone to understand the overall process and chronology of the project, work on evaluation and communication plans, improve monitoring and collaborations within the consortium.
- **progress work on products and resources**: to gather information for the first 3 inventories, to plan the next inventories and the method / stages of development of the charter and training resources.
- to explore questions in more depth, reflecting on resistance to change, to allow the evolution of perspectives and attitudes. We also had practice exchanges on teaching green building methods.





The Next Steps

Completion of the first working groups:

Sub-production O1.1: **The concepts and values of eco-construction** will be extracted from the collection of charters and declarative documents gathered and validated.

Sub-production O1.2: A single document reflecting the diversity and specificity of the **tasks and activities of eco-construction** trainers will be created and shared on the basis of the interactive information gathering sessions that were conducted within each participating country

Sub-production O1.3: The **inventory of existing training for adult trainers** identified two reference documents concerning learning units and existing assessment tools for trainers: the results of the **ESCOT** project and the reference "**trainer XXI**" and launch of the next working groups:

Sub-production O2.1: a **database on tools** for measuring the environmental impact of building materials and processes will be created.

Sub-production O2.2: A collection of information on **methods and exercises to support change** is in progress.

Deliverable O1.4: From previous sub-productions, a group must prepare a **first version of JUMP!** on which our training will be based.

Deliverable O1.5: Charter JUMP!



Preparation of the next meeting to be held in Austria from 8 to 12 April 2018 The third meeting will follow the theme of "Education, a vertical or horizontal approach? A social structure?"

- * Evaluation and validation of versions proposed by the working groups * Exchange of practices on the needs of trainers and how do we want to teach future trainers in our network?
- * Workshop on the construction of an educational practice with a global perspective that is not technological or performance focussed but more about a process of co-creation.
- * Launch of the following working groups and programming of the continuation of the project
- * General Coordination
